AUSTAT Council recognises the unique qualities and skills that each AUSTAT Alexander Teacher Trainee brings to their teacher training and the influence these qualities have on the style of AT Teacher they will become. Your creative ideas for furthering your learning are welcome.

AWARDS:

Up to three awards annually up to a maximum of \$500.00 each.

AIM:

The grants aims to enable exceptional students from an AUSTAT-accredited training school to further and deepen their study of the Alexander Technique. This financial support can go towards funding:

- Study with international/national visiting AT teachers.
- Travel interstate or overseas to study with AT teachers or courses.
- Attendance at AUSTAT conferences or other AT conferences nationally or internationally.
- Attendance at conferences/courses in related subjects to the AT.
- Enrolment in an online course on AT or associated subjects.
- Purchase of AT books or books on related topics.

ELIGIBILITY:

Currently enrolled in AUSTAT accredited training course with a minimum of 12 months of training. Current AUSTAT Student membership.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Demonstrate excellence in training and the pursuit of learning.

SELECTION PANEL:

AUSTAT Council or Council representatives recruited by Council from the AUSTAT membership.

TERMS and CONDITIONS OF THE GRANT:

- That the grant must be used within 12 months of being awarded.
- The awardee must submit a written description of their experience and learning outcomes to the AUSTAT Council, within six weeks of completion of the grant activity (600-1000 words)
- An article is written based on the above for ITM magazine (600 1500 words).
- Grant payments will be made upon proof of purchase or enrolment sent to the AUSTAT Treasurer at info@austat.org.au
- Applicants should allow seven weeks for the review process to be completed.
